

How to Add Medications to Your TPN Bag



IF YOUR TPN BAG LOOKS LIKE THIS...

- 1 Prescriber ordered medications to add to the TPN infusion will be added to the 1st port (on the bottom, far left).
- 2 Use the middle port to remove tab and then spike the bag with the infusion pump tubing.
- 3 The 3rd port on the bottom, far right) is used by the compounding pharmacy to make TPN infusion and should not be accessed by the patient or nurse.

IF YOUR TPN BAG LOOKS LIKE THIS...

- 1 Prescriber ordered medications to add to the TPN infusion will be added to the 3rd port (on the bottom, far right).
- 2 Use the 1st port (on bottom, far left) to remove tab and then spike the bag with the infusion pump tubing.
- 3 The middle port is used by the compounding pharmacy to make TPN infusion and should not be accessed by the patient or nurse.
